Note: The boundaries shown on this map are a compilation of flood plain areas, National Weland Inventory areas, areas of steep slopes (30 percent or greater slopes based upon Scott County Soil Survey), DNR Public Waters Inventory, steep slopes (greater than 18%), wetland boundaries received from the Scott SWCD, and Shoreland overlay districts (1000 foot buffer of Mill Pond, 300 foot buffer of Sand Creek, 300 foot buffer of all protected watercourses). Field verification was not done to determine wetland existence.

* Note this does not include the Metro Wildlife corridor.

Additional field work must be completed prior to development. This map was created for reference purposed only, and intended to provide a general overview of areas with possible development constraints.
