

Search & Rescue

I. Purpose

To describe in general how search and rescue will be accomplished in the City of Jordan following a disaster.

II. Responsibility

Search and rescue will normally be the responsibility of Jordan Fire Department. The Fire Chief will be in charge of directing the overall search and rescue operations by following NIMS (National Incident Management System.)

III. Supporting Agencies/Organizations

The following government and/or volunteer organization(s) would be available to assist with a major search and rescue operation:

- Jordan Police Department (including K9 and Reserves)
- Jordan Fire Department
- Mutual Aid Fire/Police Departments
- Scott County Sheriff's Deputies, Mounted Patrol & Reserves (including K9)
- SRRRMN
- Civil Air Patrol
- National Guard
- State Duty Officer can also assist on other help

IV. Supporting Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)

The City of Jordan Police and Fire Departments and other agencies responsible for conducting or participating in a search and rescue operation will develop and maintain whatever standard operating procedures (SOPs) they may need. Such SOPs may include guidance and instructions for performing search and rescue following an accident/incident involving hazardous materials, (depending on the level of hazmat response training received), terrorist incidents, etc.
