

Jordan Dog Park



Dog Park Rules:

- 1. All dogs must be properly licensed and vaccinated through the City of Jordan. Dogs must wear a collar displaying valid tags and identification at all times.
- 2. Owners or handlers must be 16 years of age and are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their dog(s).
- 3. Owners or handlers may bring no more than 3 dogs, and must remain inside of the dog park at all times.
- 4. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park. No dog is to be off leash in the parking lot or other park areas.
- 5. Children under the age of 13 must be supervised by a parent or guardian. Children should be instructed about proper behavior around dogs: no running or screaming.
- 6. Dogs must be under voice command and control and accompanied by owner or handler at all times.
- 7. Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior must be taken away from the park at first sign of aggression.
- 8. Dogs under 4 months of age, unhealthy dogs, pregnant dogs or female dogs in heat **are prohibited** from the dog park.
- 9. No digging. Owners or handlers are responsible for filling in holes.
- 10. Human food and dog food or treats are prohibited as they may incite aggressive behavior.
- 11. Smoking, alcohol, and glass containers are not allowed in the park.
- 12. Owners must clean up and dispose of all pet waste.
- 13. Report any dog bites or incidents to Jordan PD at (952) 492-2009, and in emergencies, call 911.

Location:

The Dog Park is located at the Northeast Quadrant of Sawmill Road and O'Day Drive.

Hours of Operation:

Open daily 6:00am-10:00pm



Amenities:

Parking:

Five (5) on-street parking spaces are striped on the northside of Sawmill Road.

Directions to the Dog Park:

Heading north on Broadway St., turn right onto Sawmill Road. The park is on your

left.

Starting at Lagoon Park, head south on the trail towards Hillside Drive. Take a right on Hillside Drive and follow to the underpass. Continue east until you reach the park.
