**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENT REQUEST FROM THE CITY OF JORDAN,
FIREARMS AND/OR WEAPONS ORDINANCE SECTION 121.04 TO ALLOW A LICENSED RETAILER
TO OPERATE IN THE R-1 (SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT) WITH AN APPROVED
SPECIAL HOME OCCUPATION LICENSE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The City Council of the City of Jordan, Scott County, Minnesota, will vote on the proposed ordinance 2018-02 amending Jordan, MN Code of Ordinance §121.04 regarding the update to the City Regulations pertaining to the permitted location for a licensed retailer to operate a business. The vote will occur at the January 2, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. or shortly thereafter, at the Jordan City Council Chambers, located at 116 East First Street in the City of Jordan, Minnesota.

Amendment Request: To allow a licensed retailer to operate in the R-1 (Single Family Residential District) with an approved special home occupation license.

ORDINANCE 2018-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 121.04 OF CHAPTER 121,
FIREARMS AND/OR WEAPONS SALES,
OF THE CITY CODE**

Subdivision 1. PURPOSE. The City Council for the City of Jordan, Minnesota finds that it needs to update certain regulations governing firearm and/or weapon sales to establish certain requirements for the sale of firearms within the City with an approved, and to avoid conflicts which might otherwise be associated with firearms sales in populated areas so as to promote public health, safety, and welfare.

Subdivision 2. AMENDMENT. NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JORDAN THAT Chapter 121 of the Jordan City Code is hereby amended by revising Section 121.04:

SECTION 121.04 LOCATION

The following paragraph is being amended to read as follows:

- (A) A conditional use permit granted by the city to a licensed retailer may only allow the location of the business to be in the (C-2) Central Business District, or in the (C-3) Highway Commercial District.
- (B) A special home occupation license granted by the City to a licensed retailer may only allow the location of the business to be in the (R-1) Single Family Residential District.
- (C) The business shall be open for inspection by the city without prior notification.

Subdivision 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance is effective immediately following its publication in the official newspaper of the City.
