

**CITY OF JORDAN ORDINANCE 2018-04**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 115,  
SECTION 1115.09 EXEMPTIONS OF LICENSE APPLICATION**

**Subdivision 1. PURPOSE.** This Ordinance 2018-04 is adopted to update the City's regulations to include a provision regarding transient merchants during city festivals and events. The Council finds its current City Code Chapter 115 fails to provide for transient merchant participation at city festivals and events where the activity of transient merchant sales is neither a Jordan non-profit or associated with a brick and mortar physical site within the Jordan City limits.

**Subdivision 2. ADOPTION.** NOW IT BE ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JORDAN THAT Chapter 115, Section 115.09 (B) (3), of the Jordan City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) Transient merchants both for-profit and non-profit shall be prohibited from operating within city limits during city festivals and events without written permission from the city festival or event coordinator. Jordan non-profits and existing Jordan businesses with brick and mortar physical sites within city limits shall be exempt from licensing requirements for special events if they are approved as part the event. All other non-profits and non-Jordan businesses will need to get a license to operate as part of the special event.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance shall become effective following its publication in the official newspaper of the city.
