

CITY OF JORDAN ORDINANCE 2018-06

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 115
REPEALING ORDINANCE 2018-04 AND ADDING SECTION 115.04 (B)(2)(3)**

Subd. 1. PURPOSE. This Ordinance 2018-06 is adopted to update the City's regulations to include a provision regarding transient merchants during city festivals and events. The Council finds its current City Code Chapter 115 fails to provide for transient merchant participation at city festivals and events where the activity of transient merchant sales is neither a Jordan non-profit or associated with a brick and mortar physical site within the Jordan City limits.

Subd. 2. REPEAL. NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JORDAN THAT Ordinance 2018-04 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Subd. 3. ADOPTION. NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JORDAN THAT §115.04 of the Jordan City Code is hereby amended by adding (B) (2) and (3) to read as follows:

§115.04 REGULATION OF TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

(B) *Exceptions:*

(2) Any organization or business maintaining a brick and mortar site within Jordan city limits is exempt from transient merchant licensing requirements for special events if the organization or business has been approved as part of the event by the event coordinator. All other organizations and businesses must obtain a transient merchant license to operate as part of a special event. No transient merchant even though licensed, shall operate within the city of Jordan during community festivals or special events, unless operating at the event.

(3) Licensing and use of a mobile food unit is governed by Jordan City Code Chapter 125.

EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall become effective following its publication in the official newspaper of the city.
