

**CITY OF JORDAN  
ORDINANCE 2018-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 73.08 AND 73.09 OF CHAPTER 73,  
PARKING REGULATIONS, OF THE CITY CODE**

Subdivision 1. PURPOSE. The City Council for the City of Jordan, Minnesota finds that it needs to update certain regulations governing parking to establish certain requirements for parking within the City during certain times and snow fall events so as to promote public health, safety, and welfare.

Subdivision 2. AMENDMENT. NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JORDAN THAT TITLE VII, Traffic Code/Chapter 73 Parking Regulations, Section 73.08 Parking Hours and Section 73.09 Snow Removal is hereby amended by revising Sections 73.08 and 73.09 to include the following:

**Section 73.08 Parking Hours.**

**Insert the following language:**

- (E) Between November 1 and March 31 on First Street and Water Street only, from Mill Street to Varner Street, between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m., parking shall only be allowed on an odd/even basis; on even-numbered days vehicles may park on the even-numbered side of the street and on odd-numbered days vehicles may park on the odd-numbered side of the street.

**Section 73.09 Snow Removal.**

**Repeal 73.09 in its entirety and replace it with the following:**

It is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any street after a continuous or intermittent snowfall during which there has been an accumulation of 1 inch or more of snow, or a Snow Emergency is declared, until all snow, ice and similar debris has been plowed or removed from the paved portion of the street. For purposes of this section the definition of street includes the city owned parking lots. An exception is that on First Street and Water Street only, from Mill Street to Varner Street, and in the Jordan City Hall parking lot, parking shall be allowed on an odd/even basis; on even-numbered days vehicles may park on the even-numbered side of the street and on odd-numbered days vehicles may park on the odd-numbered side of the street.

Subdivision 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective following publication in the official newspaper of the City.
