### I. Call to Order.

The Park and Recreation Commission had discussion about the location and views from the trail. Concerns were expressed if the trail was located too close to the bank that a fence would be needed in order to protect individuals from falling into Sand Creek.

Member Breeggemann made a motion, Schwingler seconded to place the trail as close to the top of Sand Creek's bank without having to construct a fence. All in favor the motion passed.

### **Review Park CIP**

Planner Janish informed members it would be wise to review the CIP to determine projects that would be beneficial to complete for the year of 2006. Members discussed the CIP and

determined to move projects that were not yet completed this year to next year and other projects were moved around (*please see attached items in bold were moved*).

Staff was directed to make the changes to the CIP and bring to the next Park and Recreation Meeting to review.
