Upcoming 2024 TH 169 Overpass Project in Sand Creek Township

Starting in the spring of 2024, Scott County, Sand Creek Township, and MnDOT will construct an overpass of Highway 169 at Bluff Drive. Access to 169 will not be maintained at Bluff Drive, avoiding conflicts with trucks/vehicles impeding high speed traffic when exiting the area. Instead, access onto 169 will be accomplished at 166th Street (Herman's Landscaping access road) which is about 1/4 mile south of Bluff Drive. Additional lanes will be added entering/exiting this intersection allowing for large trucks to accelerate and decelerate near the intersection, separate from the common travel lane, to then merge with traffic at the posted speed. This access configuration is similar to that constructed at CR 14 over 169 (near Sever's Corn Maze & MN Valley Landscape). The project will address corridor safety, access management, mobility, connectivity, accessibility, public input, and environmental considerations of the area.




2024 TH 169 Resurfacing Project

Starting in the spring of 2024, MnDOT will be resurfacing 169 from the north Jordan city limits, through Sand Creek Township, to Co. Rd. 15/Marystown Road in Shakopee. In addition to resurfacing the 169 pavement, the project will reduce access to several driveways along 169 in order to improve safety. The proposed access restrictions include removal/closure of six median accesses to residential properties as well as the two access modifications identified on the map at the right and layouts below.
