A. Outdoor Seating Ordinance Amendment

Planning Consultant, Kansier, provided a summary of proposed amendments to the zoning ordinance to allow for outdoor seating in the General Business (C-2) and Highway Commercial (C-3) Zoning Districts to be a permitted use rather than a conditional use.

Kansier outlined key issues such as setbacks, distance from residential uses, hours of operation, seating area size, noise, and lighting as a result from such use. Also addressed were conditions incorporated into the zoning ordinance such as the requirement of being located on private property and not on public sidewalks or other right-of-of ways.

Kansier recommended the Planning Commission discuss the item, hold the public hearing and provide a recommendation to City Council.

Johnson asked if businesses with current CUPs would need to adhere to such ordinances. Kansier stated she could not see the city going out and enforcing new conditions on current businesses as long as the same use continues.

Motion by Johnson to approve the outdoor seating ordinance amendment as presented. Seconded by Bohlman. All other commissioners present voted ayes. The motion was declared carried.
