A. Grassman Park Shelter Proposal

Cochran presents an overview of new park shelter proposal for Grassman, prepared by Mike Waltman. One shelter is set for 2022 and two more as future installments. Haas clarifies that estimate may be low because trees are not included. Picnic patio will be 16x16 and shelter will be 12x16. City's public works team is capable of doing project, but may take slightly longer because of other responsibilities. Goebel likes that the park may bring more regional attention to the area. Breeggemann wants to make sure proper tree types are selected to avoid damage to the shelter. New addition ground cover will be mulch. The commission is in favor of adding another large, machine moved tree to the plan with benches surrounding trunk, and possible extra limestone benches by playground.
