CITY INFORMATION / REMINDERS

Watering Requirements

There are watering restrictions seven days a week, year round in Jordan. The restrictions include the odd/even system, plus time restrictions. -Customers whose home or business address ends with an odd number may sprinkle the lawn only on odd numbered days.

-Customers whose home or business address ends with an even number may sprinkle the lawn only on even numbered days.

-No sprinkling is permitted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. A 30-day exception will be allowed for new seed or sod.

Remember most lawns need only 1" of water a week. The best time to water is between 3-9 a.m. when it is the coolest and the least amount of wind. If you notice someone watering illegally, please contact the Police

- If possible, post your address near a porch light, or use reflective numbers.
- House numbers should be at least 4 inches tall.
