## Organics / Yard Waste Recycling in Jordan



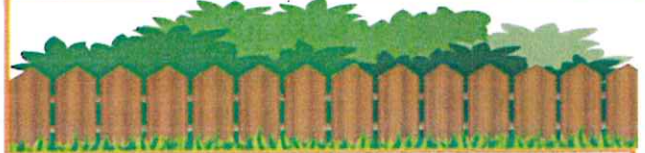
Organics Recycling is offered to Jordan, St. Lawrence Township, and Sand Creek Township Residents for free!

Yard Waste Recycling (Leaves & Grass Only) is available free of charge for Jordan residents. The combined drop-off site is located at the Police Department parking lot (705 Syndicate Street).

To participate, fill out the Household Organics & Yard Waste Sign Up form online or stop by City Hall during regular business hours.

After you sign up, you will be contacted via email to let you know the key fob is ready. Please check your spam junk mail inbox and note it may take up to two weeks for the fob to be ready. You can stop by City Hall to pick up the fob once it is done

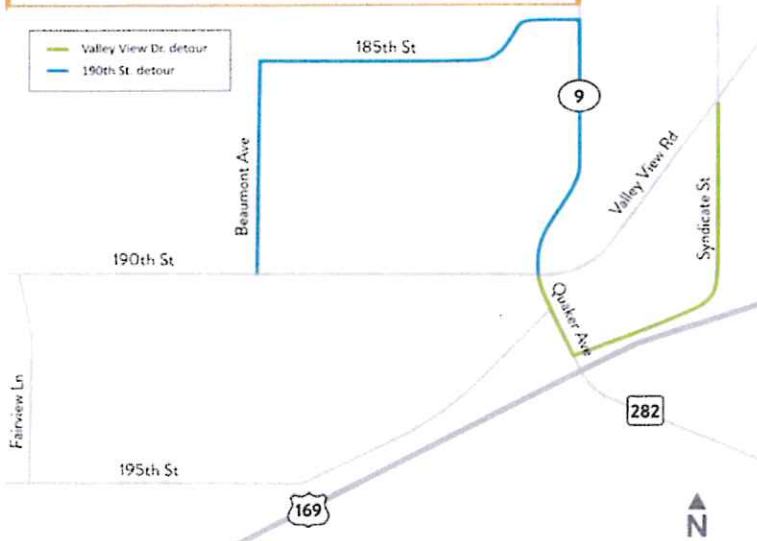


# UPCOMING PROJECT INFORMATION

## Hwy 169 / Hwy 282 / CR 9 Interchange – Let the Construction Begin!

### Overview

Construction of a new interchange at Hwy 169 and Hwy 282 / Co. Rd. 9 has officially begun! MnDOT, in partnership with the City of Jordan and Scott County, will construct a new interchange at Hwy 169 and Hwy 282/Co. Rd. 9 in Jordan. This project will improve safety and traffic flow, modify or build bridges, and create safer options and better connections for pedestrians and bicyclists. An overview of the project improvements can be referenced in the layout.

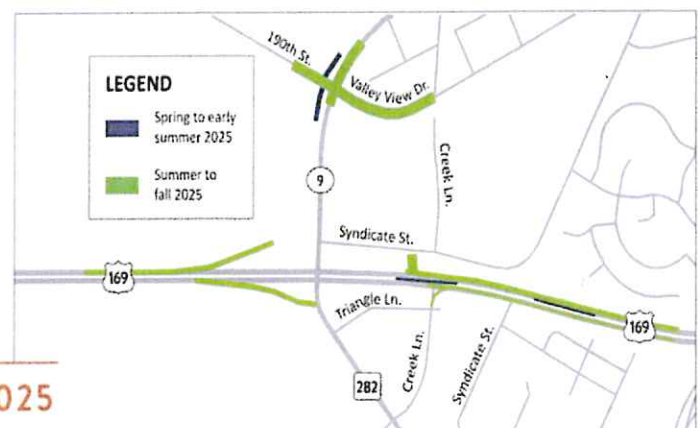


### What to Expect in 2025

- Starting this spring and extending throughout the summer and fall, Hwy 169 will be reduced to a single-lane in each direction. A map of the construction staging for 2025 can be referenced to your left.
- Hwy 282 will remain open/accessible throughout the 2025 construction season.
- The Creek Ln. access onto NB Hwy 169 will be temporarily closed in summer 2025.
- The Syndicate St. access onto NB Hwy 169 will be permanently closed starting in late spring

The roundabout at Co. Rd. 9 and Valley View Dr. will be constructed half at a time to maintain local access. 190th St. and Valley View Dr. will be closed and detoured starting in summer 2025, but not at the same time (see map). Co. Rd. 9 will remain open during roundabout construction.

 flush your systems.  
 The water should  
 clear in about 10  
 minutes.
