



Sunset Drive Improvements Project in Jordan Receives LRIP Funding

April 02, 2024, Jordan, MN – The City of Jordan and Jordan Public Schools (ISD 717) were selected to receive Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) funds for the Sunset Drive Improvements Project. The project was selected to receive \$1.5M in LRIP funds appropriated by the legislature in 2023.

The Sunset Drive Improvements will improve access, safety, and function of Sunset Drive, which serves as the main access to the Jordan Schools. The project will include the construction of two compact roundabouts with pedestrian safety facilities coupled with a series of driveway access closures along Sunset Drive. The project will improve both pedestrian and vehicle safety by reducing vehicle speeds, reducing pedestrian/vehicle interaction points, reducing traffic congestion/delay, reducing serious injury crashes, and simplifying/shortening pedestrian crossings.
