Night to Unite provides an excellent opportunity for all of Jordan's residents to come together for this great cause. Community engagement builds trust and aids in reducing criminal activity.

In the past, registered block parties occur between 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. and have been visited by representatives of the Jordan Police and Fire departments, and Ridgeview ambulance services, and many other public safety organizations.

Block captains are responsible for organizing a block party on the night of the event. Block parties can be as small or large as the captains can manage and are typically a pot-luck or an inexpensive cookout promoting neighborhood spirit.
